



In dialog with Lawrence Weiner

January 28 - February 25. 2023

The gallery is proud to present a work designed by Lawrence Weiner specially for the gallery in 1990 and installed in 1993.

30 years after, we are taking the opportunity to launch a dialogue with the history of the gallery and the artists that wrote that history with our present by producing a performance by Theresa Patzschke.

Lawrence has developed his own way to make art using his unique way with language. Conceptual and minimal, his work offers a mental projection for an ideal esthetic vision.

Theresa Patzschke writes: Do words always have to mean something? Can't they just mean? The performance is about telling a story through language. But it is also about creating images that have a more direct effect on the viewer/listener, just like painting, sculpture or music. In the performance, the transition between flute melodies and language paragraphs is almost fluid, the two forms of expression conveying meaning and emotions, sound and structure in a similar way.

Theresa will also present a series of collages in 'La Cuisine' space.

The music heard in the space is a collaboration of Lawrence with a song writer : Ned Sublette. He made three albums with Lawrence. Lawrence gave him words and Ned turned them into songs. The words didn't take Lawrence long, but composing and producing the songs took Ned many hours of labor. *Ships At Sea, Sailors and Shoes* (released in 1993) was the first. The second was *Monsters from the Deep* (1998). The third, which has not yet been released, was (is) *Stones Tied With String*, recorded one night in 2004, a solo album of Ned singing and playing guitar.

We can hear in the gallery *Ships At Sea, Sailors and Shoes* (1993), Ned used the words Lawrence gave him in the exact order he had written them.

Lawrence's texts made peculiarly effective songs. They're not like anything else. Ned declares that he learned a lot about song writing in the course of working with them.

As our dialogue program with the work of Lawrence we believe that the compositions and the production of this album is a relevant way to echo Lawrence's art: Minimalism, large spaces and humor might be the transcription of Lawrence work into music. It is also a non material way of expression.
